1. Did you forget \_\_\_\_\_?

*"You went into the house of uncircumcised men and ate with them." Acts 11:3*

*But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them." Luke 15:2*

2. We continue to \_\_\_\_\_.

*Then I heard a voice telling me, 'Get up, Peter. Kill and eat.' "I replied, 'Surely not, Lord! Nothing impure or unclean has ever entered my mouth.' Acts 11:7-8*

*"Lord," Ananias answered, "I have heard many reports about this man and all the harm he has done to your saints in Jerusalem." Acts 9:13*
